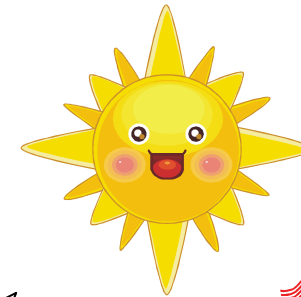

9:30AM – 11:00AM**

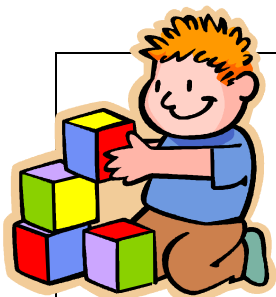

Parent Class* Schedule:

Week 1 - June 9 - Introduction to Early Intervention Vocabulary and Developmental Milestones – Why we do what we do...

Week 2 - June 16 - **Sensory I** - The Proprioceptive and Vestibular Senses: Learn about the hidden senses and the effect they have in our every day lives.

Week 3 - June 23 – “Help! My Infant has Become a Toddler” **Behavior Interventions** with our Licensed Social Worker Jeanne Guarneri.

Week 4 - June 30 - **Sensory II**- Sensory Play and Activities for home – Learn how to create fun and cheap sensory experiences for your child. Create a sensory project to take home.

Week 5 - July 7 - Auditory and Visual Processing: Focusing on Autism, ADHD and the different world of “Premies”.

Week 6 - July 14 - **Communication I**- Teaching Augmentative and pre-Verbal skills to your toddler – reducing frustration...

Week 7 - July 21 - **Communication II**- Oral Motor Skills with an EIP Speech and Language Pathologist – here about EI strategies to work with low tone children and attack feeding issues.

Week 8 - July 28 - Gross Motor Skills and Activities with an EIP Physical Therapist – Learn home strategies to reinforce this important building block in your child’s development.

Week 9 - August 4 - What would you like your doctor to know: Discussing your concerns with a Dr. can be hard – we’ll help you formulate questions to get the answers you need! Wrap Up Session.
